STATE ARTS PLAN 2020

RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

State Arts Plan 2020 recommits the Ohio Arts Council to our shared goals—to invest, engage, innovate, and lead.

INVEST

- ▶ Made grant awards in each of Ohio's 88 counties for the second straight biennium
- ▶ Worked in partnership with Ohio House of Representatives and Ohio Art Education Association to continually exhibit art created by high school students from all 99 House districts
- ▶ Earned one of the three largest state arts partnership awards in the nation from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) for the 10th year in a row
- ▶ Successfully retooled folk and traditional arts programming, including the contracting of an NEA-supported contracted folk arts expert to strengthen relationships in Appalachian Ohio and organize professional development opportunities for Ohio's folk and traditional artists, efforts that resulted in an increase in directed NEA folk arts funding
- ▶ Launched new pilot funding program designed to support the unique and valuable work of statewide arts service organizations
- ▶ Made direct investments that supported the career development of artists with disabilities and the organizations that serve them
- ▶ Revised Final Report forms for all programs to better assess grantee outcomes and streamline reporting requirements
- ▶ Added new ARTIE (online grant application program) validations to improve error-checking and completeness of submitted applications
- ▶ Updated *Guidelines* revisions policies to double the length of time policies are in effect from one year to two, reducing internal administrative burden and making procedures more predictable and consistent for applicants

ENGAGE

- ▶ Launched a “Featured Friday” social media campaign that highlighted grantee successes and innovations every week
- ▶ Introduced live-streamed video technologies to broadcast agency events such as gallery tours, artist talks, and awards ceremonies in real time
- ▶ Revised Riffe Gallery metrics and internal planning work created to guide future audience engagement and programming
- ▶ Created a social media plan to measure online performance and impact on a variety of platforms
- ▶ Developed agency brochure for events and in-person meeting opportunities
- ▶ Increased visibility throughout Ohio through more frequent visits with constituents in the field and greater brand awareness
- ▶ Supported professional development for arts administrators through encouraging participation in the LEAD (Leadership Exchange in Arts and Disability) Conference

LEAD

- ▶ Successfully planned and held the Arts Impact Ohio statewide professional development conference, attracting nearly 300 attendees
- ▶ Continued to grow the TeachArtsOhio program, including into underfunded communities, increasing applications in each successive fiscal year
- ▶ Continued refining and expanding successful fellowship and internship programs to attract high-caliber candidates and create meaningful career development opportunities for emerging arts leaders
- ▶ Maintained up-to-date EEO policy and Diversity and Inclusion plan in accordance with state guidance

INNOVATE

- ▶ Adopted a new meeting and webinar platform to better engage with constituents
- ▶ Promoted ongoing constituent-driven projects noted for their innovativeness in agency communications, social media, etc.
- ▶ Encouraged previous Fund Every County grantees to come into operating- and project-based grant programs
- ▶ Partnered with the Ohio Department of Education and the Ohio Alliance for Arts Education to launch a comprehensive data analysis dashboard online via the National Arts Education Data Project partnership
- ▶ Hosted webinars on data analytics, social networking, grantwriting, accessible marketing and event planning, emergency preparedness, and more
- ▶ Provided an interactive heat map of grantees by fiscal year as grant awards were announced
- ▶ Expanded use of online SmartSheet project management platform across departments and work teams
- ▶ Updated online Riffe Gallery archival directory of past exhibitions
- ▶ Expanded folk and traditional arts work, including developing videos celebrating Ohio Heritage Fellows
- ▶ Represented the agency and arts sector in general in the ongoing development of the SmartSimple GMS 360 grantmaking platform




Flashback to Now: OAC Support for Individual Artists


The Inaugural Juried Exhibition


Go Figure: 13 Ohio Artists’ Explorations of the Human Form

Artists of the Winding Road A-Z
April 7 – April 23, 2016

Artists of the Winding Road A-Z was an exhibition spotlighting the community of creatives guiding Appalachian Ohio to civic recovery and renovation through the arts. Painters, ceramists, and sculptors from Athens to Zanesville created a wide range of contemporary art and fine craft. Seven of those artists came together in *Artists of the Winding Road A-Z*, curated by Susan K. Gottlieb of Zanesville, Ohio.



Material Pulses: 8 Viewpoints

May 12 – July 16, 2016

Nancy Crow, an internationally recognized quilt-maker and the co-founder of Quilt Surface Design Symposium and Quilt National, curated this exhibition of quilts and textiles. Though curated by Ohio-born Crow, the exhibition featured eight international artists hailing from the Midwest to the Southwest, Canada to the United Kingdom. These artists investigated color, pattern, and size through traditional and experimental quilt-making applications.



Earthy Delights

August 4 – October 9, 2016

Curated by Kenyon College Professor Marcella Hackbardt, *Earthy Delights* was an exhibition of contemporary photography by 15 Ohio artists that featured Earth's varied textures and places, as well as imagery inspired by it. Artists' methods varied from traditional analog to digital. These artworks showcased a variety of photographic processes, employed great technical skill, and explored relationships in their themes particularly of humans and Earth.



Watercolor Ohio 2016: 39th Annual Juried Exhibition

October 27, 2016 – January 7, 2017

Watercolor Ohio 2016 was a broad and diverse display of watercolor and its modern applications. The Ohio Watercolor Society (OWS), a member-based nonprofit dedicated to artists working with water-based media, produced this annual competitive juried exhibition. Carrie Burns Brown, a mixed-media artist and National Watercolor Society member living in South Carolina, served as exhibition juror. The call for entry was open to all OWS members, and 80 pieces were juried into the exhibition. Burns Brown selected the top three award-winners, as well as the top 25 pieces that traveled to other cultural institutions in Ohio following the Riffe Gallery exhibition.



Come Along With Me

January 26 – April 15, 2017

Come Along With Me, curated by Richard Fletcher, associate professor in the Department of Classics at the Ohio State University, was the fourth curated collaboration between the Riffe Gallery and Ohio Art League. The selected artworks represented a range of media from painting, sculpture, photography, video, and site-specific assemblages. Fletcher dedicated his research and teaching practices to how ancient literature, philosophy, and mythology can be reactivated through contemporary artistic practices. These themes were explored in the exhibition by the artists' contemplation of how their artwork communicates life lessons.



After Hours: Artwork by State of Ohio Employees

May 4 – July 8, 2017

After Hours: Artwork by State of Ohio Employees featured artwork by 43 state employees across Ohio. Photography, sculpture, textiles, and painting highlighted the diversity of State of Ohio employees' artistic voices. Jurors included Mary Cusick, former director of TourismOhio; Kevin Milstead, assistant deputy director of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Human Resources Division; and Stephanie Rond, visual artist and *After Hours* exhibition consultant.

PERCENT FOR ART

The Percent for Art program became effective July 1, 1990 through the enactment of Ohio legislation recognizing the state’s responsibility to foster culture and the arts and to encourage the development of artists and craftspeople. The legislation provides funds for the acquisition, commissioning, and installation of works of art for new or renovated public buildings with appropriations of more than \$4 million. For these projects, the law provides that 1 percent of the total appropriation will be allocated for the acquisition, commissioning, and installation of artwork. This past biennium, 14 Percent for Art projects were either started or completed in FY 2016 and FY 2017.


